Think About This...

- Who has God already placed in your life?
- Is there someone you see regularly who may need encouragement, friendship, or prayer?
- Do you sometimes become so busy that you miss opportunities to truly notice others?

How might an ordinary relationship become an opportunity to share the love of Christ? his Week's Challenge-

Think of **one person** God may be placing on your heart. Pray for that person by name this week. Don't worry about what you are supposed to say or do. Simply pray: "**Lord, show me how I can love this person well.**"

Then pay attention to the opportunities God provides.
